
# TILOS Support Note Known Issue - Sector Shading

## In TILOS v9.x

Distance profile sector shading was shifted to the left one cell; the color was placed on the preceding sector and ended at the start of the intended sector. This bug was a visual/graphical issue only; it did not affect calculations (which are based on the starting point of the sector).


In the image to the right, the yellow and blue sector shading should have been applied to the sectors to their right (as shown below)



### In TILOS v10.2 MR1+

Distance profile sector shading is now applied to the correct cells. The colors start at the beginning of the sectors as intended.

Therefore, your v9.x projects may look different after you convert them to v10.2 MR2 and above. Distance scale sector text placement was not affected; it is correct in both versions.
