Tilos 11.1 includes this enhancement:

## Trimble Identity version 4

• Trimble Identity (TID), which is the sign-in functionality used for fast, secure access to Trimble software products, has been updated. Install Tilos 11.1 to continue using TID for your Tilos integration with Trimble Quadri, as well as to benefit from enhanced security features that protect your company's data.

*Note:* This upgrade requires that all software products accessed via TID must be updated by August 30, 2021 to avoid disruptions in service.



This Tilos release also includes fixes for reported or discovered cases in which:

## Licensing

- When switching license modes in version 11.0, you were automatically signed out from TID. In versions 11.1 and above, this will not occur
- The License Manager interface was confusing; the screens have been re-organized to improve your user experience. See <u>Tilos Help Installing and Licensing</u> in the <u>Tilos Community Library</u> for details.



#### Known issues

• The Trimble Connect property set (PSET) feature prototype has stopped working and will not be fixed until a future version. If you wish to explore this prototyped Tilos - Connect integration, please contact Tilos Support.



- If you cannot create a PDF file using the Presentations printing mechanism, replace/add files on your computer by unpacking the zip below to the folder C:\Program Files (x86)\TILOS\Tilos111\svgtopdf. If you have a different installation path, they are located in the installation folder under the svgtopdf subfolder.
  <u>Download the SVG to PDF.zip here.</u> Note: You may need to sign in/run as an Admin when extracting the zip file. (TIL-1501)
- When using presentation mode for printing , if you try to preview multiple pages for which the zoom level is not 100%, using the Next/Previous page buttons can result in missing lines and/or empty pages. Any PDFs or SVGs that you generate are not affected by this issue. (TIL-1400)
- It is recommended that you do not use overlapping sector profiles in sector-based activity calculations; they are not working properly. (TIL-1231)
- When displaying some sector profiles in a distance scale, the result is not as expected. (TIL-1019)
- The speed calculation for one side of an activity can be incorrect when using sector-based speed calculations. The issue only arises when a task is in a positive direction. If task coordinates are changed, then the behavior is as expected. (TIL-1339)
- User-defined fields (UDFs) were not being added from Asta Powerproject 15 when using the Powerproject macro. Distance information was transferred properly (without formatting problems) from Powerproject 14, but from versions 15+. (TIL-1188) Therefore, Powerproject versions above 14 are not supported unless you deploy a Tilos fix for Asta Powerproject 15; to do so, see the <u>support note</u> in the <u>Tilos Community</u>.
- When you try to print to PDFs larger than, e.g., 5 m, you may encounter an error message similar to: "The size of this page exceeds the permitted limits. Some content may not be displayed." Even though Tilos version 11.0 can print larger PDFs than earlier versions, all PDF read/write applications have a size limitation beyond our control.
